



GUESS WHAT MASH-UP GAME

Head to the children's room to grab a Guess What slip and sign -in for the game.

What is the Guess What Mash-Up Game?

A guessing game with multiple photos of different types of rocks and minerals as well as all things rock and roll. Your job, each week, is to guess four items correctly and then you can get a grand prize raffle slip.

How do I take a guess?

Head to the children's reference desk and sign-in with a librarian. They will give you a slip of paper to put your guess on. Go to the teen room and choose which four photos you'd like to take a guess on.

How many times can I guess?:

You may only guess once a week, four photos at a time. You may NOT guess the same four photos each week. Your answers are recorded.

Can I get clues or ask for help?

We will have a Rocks and Minerals reference book in order to help you identify the items. For the Rock and Roll portion, we strongly encourage you to use your other library resources such as logging on to the teen room computers and conduct some research. By coming up with great search terms, we're confident you will find your answers. After you've exhausted all resources, a librarian will give you a clue!

FAQ's

Tweens & Teens now join the SRG together, grades 4 and up!

How does the SRG work?

Sign up in the children's room, grab a folder that contains two book logs and start reading. You get a prize AND a grand prize raffle ticket for every SIX hours read. That's right, Tweens and Teens get to read in hours now as well.

Winners of our 3 Grand Prize Baskets will be announced the first week of September.

What materials do I need?

You only need a reading log (*don't lose it!*) and books/items to read or listen to. If you need extra book logs or brochure, stop by or they are available on the Teen Page of our website.

How do I get a prize?

For every six hours (two rows on your time log) you may come in and get a prize.

How do I enter in for the Grand Prize Basket?

Just like the small prizes, read for six hours (two rows on your time log) and then you may come to the children's room to fill out a raffle ticket.

How do I earn extra raffle tickets?

Here's where your skills will be put to the test, the "Guess What Mash-up game". We have pictures displayed on the outer parts of the bookshelves of the Teen Room. The pictures contain types of Rocks and Minerals and also photos of Rock and Roll bands, icons or rock and roll symbols of the past and present. It is your job to figure out which is which or who is who. Check out the inside panel for more information.

Program Descriptions

Joint Children's program: Programs that are labeled "Joint children's programs" are programs that our younger tweens can attend. There will be one sign up between the children's and tween/teen department.

Rockin' Fridays : Rockin' Fridays are your chance to drop in the teen room and get a chance to complete any of our projects you may miss during the week. Both Rockin' Fridays in August will be a combination of all the Tween/Teen craft projects that you can make.
