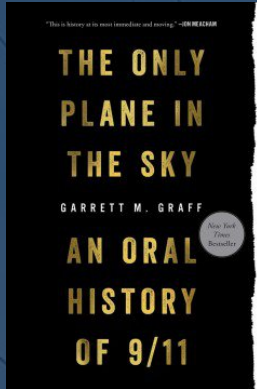
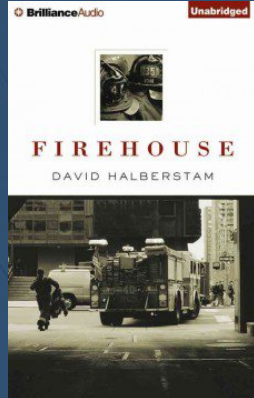

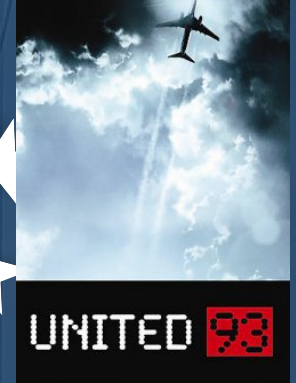

**Firehouse** (David Halberstam). A company of Manhattan firemen on 9/11.



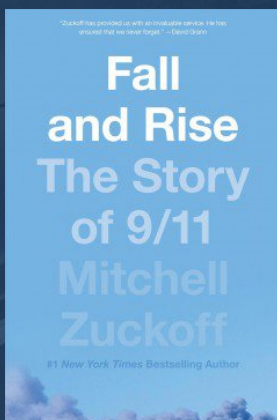

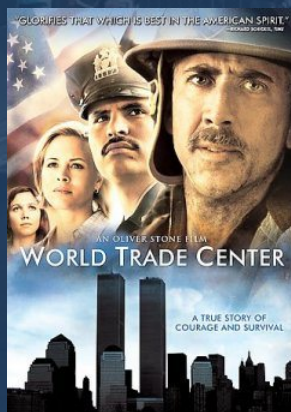
DVD. **United 93**. Forty Passengers and crew who stood up as one against terrorists over Shanksville, PA.
