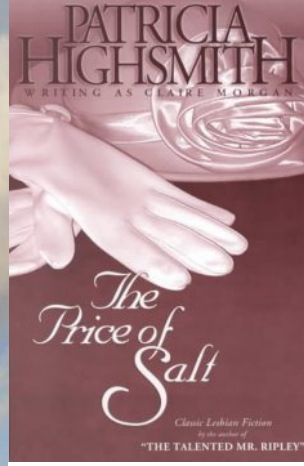
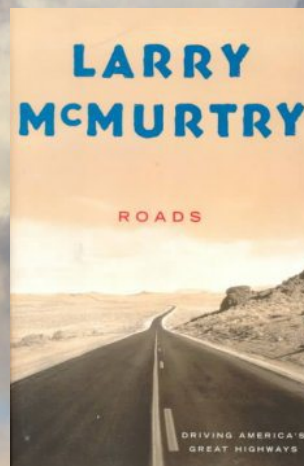


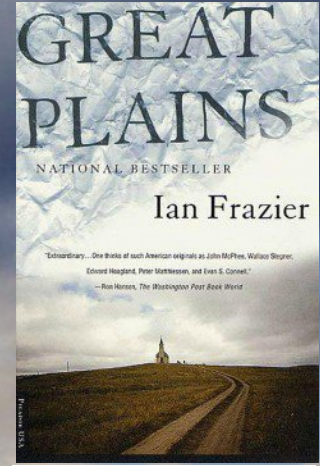

NF. **Roads: Driving America's Great Highways** (Larry McMurtry). Big skies and room to contemplate on the interstates.

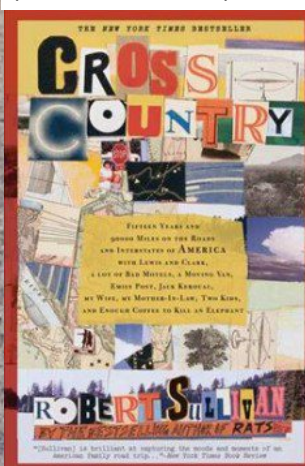

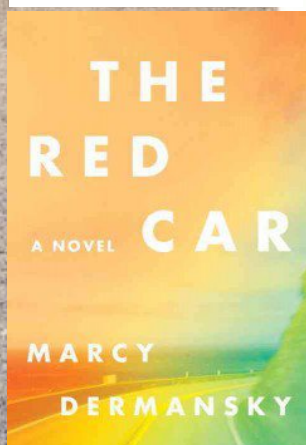

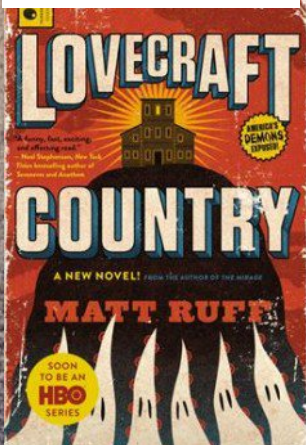
